### Board Composition and Responsibilities

A fifteen-member board appointed by the Governor to serve three-year terms. There are no limits as to how many terms a board member may serve. Any member of the public may nominate someone for appointment to the board. Board members are Wisconsin citizens recognized for their accomplishments in the arts, humanities, business, education or public service. The board includes members from urban and rural areas across the state and from diverse racial, economic and cultural backgrounds. The Board elects its leadership (executive committee) at the Arts Board’s annual meeting each May.

### Board Responsibilities

The Board hires its executive director and the executive director hires the rest of the staff. Board members set policy for the agency and consider funding recommendations made by peer review panels. The members meet a minimum of four times per year (in Madison, Milwaukee, at the site of the WI Governor’s Conference on Tourism, and in one other

community) and all meetings are open to the public. Standing committees include the Executive, Budget/Finance, External Relations, Nominating, Personnel and Strategic Planning. We are currently re-energizing our Access Committee, focused on people with disabilities. Ad hoc committees are convened, as needed. Board members also act as non-voting chairs of the peer review grant panels.
