

# Grants

The Wisconsin Arts Board makes its biggest impact through the distribution of grants for arts projects and programming throughout the state. From small town art centers to urban dance companies, it's more than likely that grant money from the Wisconsin Arts Board helped make it happen.

*Thank you to everyone who applied at our October 16 deadline. So, what's next?*

Grant applications are highly competitive, and our staff examines each application before passing it along to panelists for review. The Grant Proposal Review Panel meeting is scheduled for November 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>. Panel meetings are open to the public and applicants are encouraged to attend.

*Note to applicants:*

There is no need to RSVP if you plan to attend. Once you determine when your application is scheduled for review (see below), we advise you to arrive at least an hour prior to that time, and to stay for an hour following that time. We share that advice because panels are not always able to stick strictly to the published times. Keep in mind that applicants are in attendance to observe only; discussion with panelists is not allowed. You will be notified via email of your grant status by December 12, following the Wisconsin Arts Board's December board meeting.
