Wisconsin Arts Board

The Wisconsin Arts Board was established by Chapter 90, Laws of 1973, as the state agency responsible for the support and development of the arts in Wisconsin.

More specifically, the State Legislature directed the Arts Board to continually study the artistic and cultural activities within the state; assist communities in creating and developing their own arts programs; encourage and assist freedom of artistic expression; and plan and implement a program of contracts with or grants-in-aid to groups or individuals of exceptional talent engaged in or concerned with the arts.

To meet these responsibilities, the Arts Board operates as both a service agency providing information and technical assistance and a funding agency providing matching grants and fellowships for arts activities and projects throughout Wisconsin.

As a funding agency, the Arts Board assists arts organizations and individual artists through a variety of programs designed to provide broad public access to the arts, strengthen the state's artistic resources, and create opportunities for individuals of exceptional talent. Financial support programs include Organizational and Individual Projects, Artistic Program Support, Salary Assistance, Community Projects, Fellowships, Artists-In-Residence, and Percent for Art. Through these programs the Board supports every artistic discipline and every segment of the arts community in the state including individual artists, community art groups, arts producing and exhibiting organizations, government units, schools and other institutions.

Through the newly created Percent for Art Program, the Arts Board helps to encourage the employment of visual artists and to increase the public's access to works of visual art. Through the Board's Research and Information Program the agency serves as a statewide resource for information about the arts and promotes Wisconsin's artistic resources through publications, workshops and research.

Members of the Board

Heading the Wisconsin Arts Board is a twelve-member citizen board responsible for agency policy and for final review and decisions on all applications for funding. Appointed to three-year terms by the Governor, members of the board serve on a voluntary, non-salaried basis. Members of the board during fiscal 1983 were:

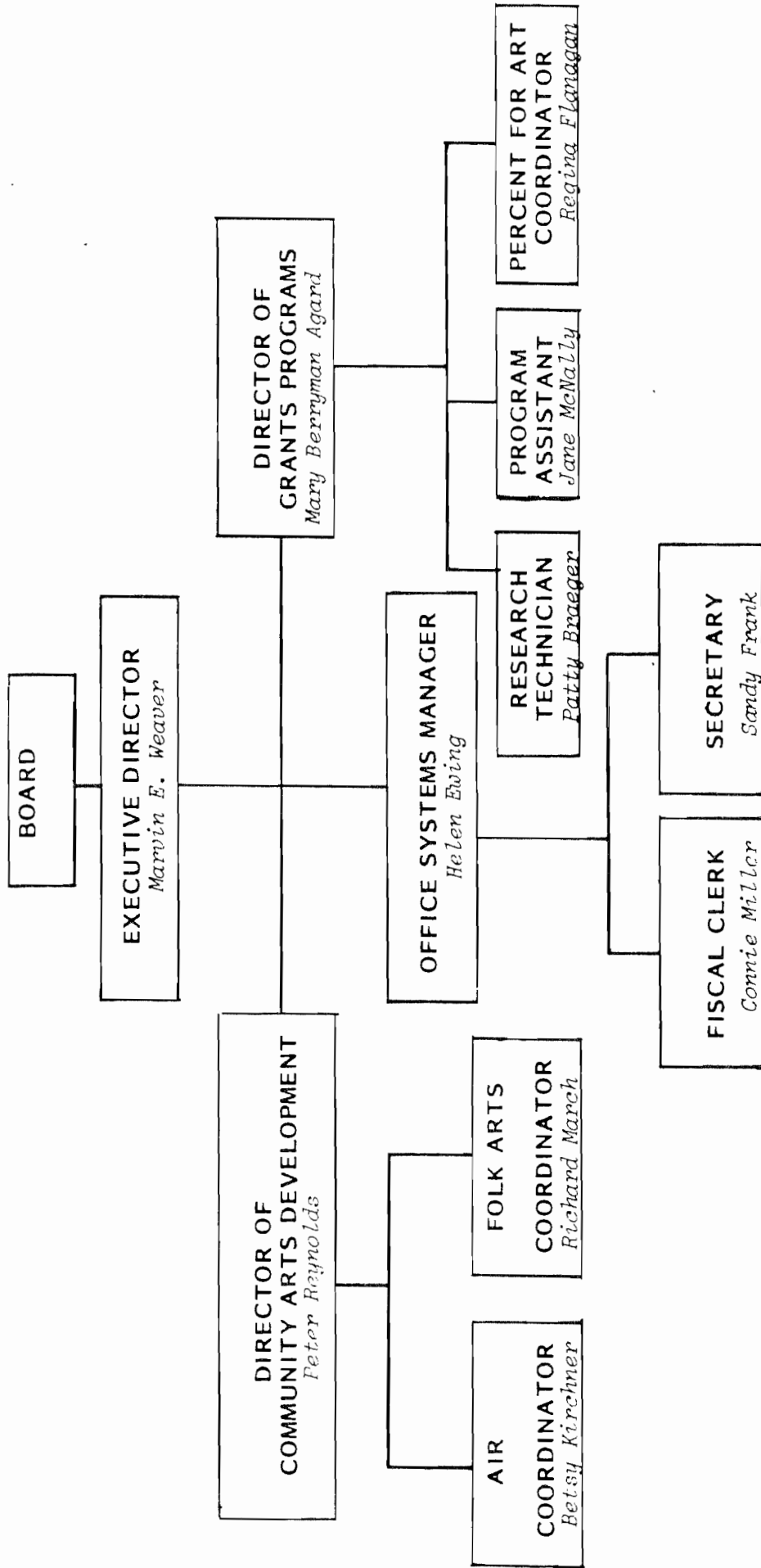

Artists-in-Residence

The Artists-in-Residence Program provides for the professional development of artists and for broad public access to their works by supporting opportunities for artists to live and work in communities throughout Wisconsin. The program awards matching grants to schools and other non-profit organizations to have professional artists in residence for periods ranging from one week to a full year.

During fiscal 1983, the Arts Board awarded grants for 83 Artists-in-Residence projects in the areas of visual arts, filmmaking, creative writing, music, theatre, dance, storytelling, jazz, and folk arts. Exemplary programs included the first full year jazz residency at Baraboo Schools. Other residencies included collaborative projects between artists from different disciplines. These collaborations proved most exciting in terms of the future possibilities for these types of projects.

Other activities during 1982-83 included an expansion of conferences and technical assistance workshops for artists and educators, increases in the number and length of residency projects, and joint sponsorship with the Department of Public Instruction of a special two week summer residency for talented high school students. This residency included students from all areas of the state working with master artists in the areas of painting and sculpture, music improvisation, creative writing, dance and theatre.

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Grants Programs

General Grants

The purpose of the Grants Program is to promote the artistic growth of Wisconsin artists and arts organizations and to provide opportunities for active audience participation, especially for those in geographically isolated areas and with limited local arts resources.

The Grants Program now offers:

Individual Projects - matching grants for costs associated with the completion of works in progress.

Organizational Projects - matching grants for costs associated with administrative or artistic projects.

Salary Assistance - structured administrative support. These funds account for 15% of the Arts Board's grants budget and are very competitive.

Performing Arts Network - Wisconsin - matching grants to community based performing arts sponsors for artistic fees.

Artistic Program Support - support for the artistic costs of major state institutions.

Fellowships - unrestricted cash awards for 6 outstanding Wisconsin visual and literary artists.

Emergency Action Grant - small, emergency grants extended on the agreement of the Executive Director and the Board's Chairperson.

The Arts Board made 166 awards from the Grants Program, totaling \$692,300. Of this total, \$199,300 were federally appropriated funds and \$493,000 were state appropriated funds. These grants provided assistance to art projects and activities in every county in the state.

Community Arts Grants

The purpose of the Community Arts Development Program is to encourage broad public involvement and local responsibility for the planning and support of arts programs which address community needs and goals through a variety of arts experiences and which preserve a place in contemporary life for the traditional arts.

The Community Arts Program is the Arts Board's most effective vehicle for providing all Wisconsin citizens, especially those in underserved geographic regions, with access to the arts. Through this program, the Arts Board awards matching grants to community arts organizations either for the support of local arts activities administered by the organization or for the development of the organization itself. Utilizing both state and federal revenues, the Community Arts program has been able to support a variety of activities throughout the state. Activities supported included festivals, workshops, classes, management training, concerts, outreach services, and visual arts exhibitions.

Grants Programs

In 1983, the Community Arts Program developed a Folk Arts component to support, preserve and present the traditional art forms in Wisconsin. Launched at the close of FY 1983, the Folk Arts component includes folklore programs in schools, teacher training, technical assistance and funding for local folk art projects.

The Community Arts Program convened state-wide and regional meetings in 1982-83 for development of a program of presenter-based fee support. A network of seventeen performing arts presenters across the state was established for skill sharing, information exchange and cooperation. First year results of this effort confirm substantial increases in attendance, numbers of performances supported and in the management and marketing capabilities of presenters.

Staff assistance to some seventeen communities, together with a series of state-wide and local public meetings, was undertaken to prepare applicants for filing preliminary applications for the Wisconsin Challenge Grant program. Technical assistance to Challenge Grant participants will continue throughout fiscal 1984 as the Arts Board provides workshops and consultants for local fund raising development, marketing, planning, programming and community arts needs assessment.

Percent for Art Program

Recognizing that art is an integral part of our environment, the Wisconsin Legislature in 1980 created a program that provides money to be spent to purchase or commission original works of art for state constructed public buildings.

Under the law, 2/10 of one percent of the funding for new state building projects costing \$250,000 or more must be used to acquire works of art by living artists, preferably from Wisconsin. The benefits from the program include employment opportunities for Wisconsin artists, public access to works of art on a daily basis, and a reaffirmation of the quality of human creativity.

The impact of this legislation is unique and important. The state will build a collection of public art and artists will enjoy new opportunities to earn a living from their art. Unlike assistance provided to visual artists by other Arts Board programs, the Percent for Art Program works on the basis of a straight business arrangement for the purchase of a work of art. The Arts Board convenes an Advisory Committee to select works of art for direct purchase or to commission an artist to design an artwork for the project.

In the fiscal 1981-83 biennium, the State Building Commission approved forty-seven projects for inclusion in the program. These projects will generate up to \$495,300 in sales and commissions to Wisconsin artists. The projects include university buildings, state office buildings, a veteran's home, a military installation, state correctional institutions and a university fine arts center.

Artworks have been acquired for seventeen state buildings since the Program was activated in 1981.
